Mr. Beck has since January 2023 performed the role of Deputy Regional Director of UNFPA's Asia and the Pacific Regional Office in an interim capacity. He joined the Regional Office in December 2018 as Programme Adviser.

Before that he was the UNFPA Country Representative for the United Nations Population Fund in the Philippines from March 2014, where he started his career as Programme Officer for UNFPA Philippines from 1997 to 2000.

Prior to taking up his position as Country Representative, over the previous decade he held various positions at UNFPA Headquarters in New York including having served in an advisory capacity to the Executive Director and Deputy Executive Directors for more than six years. He re-joined UNFPA in 2005 after having undertaken consultancy work in the health sector in almost 20 countries across three continents over a 5 year period.

He graduated from the University of Copenhagen in 1997 with a Master's Degree in Economics specializing in development economics and demography. He was born in Gentofte, Denmark and is married with two children.
