Objectives/Methodology

Objectives:

For understanding how AFPPD can best serve our member countries to fulfill the Programme of Action of ICPD (Cairo/Nairobi+25) and the SDGs by the year 2030.

Methodology:

The questionnaires were sent to all 33 member countries (13 responses from 11 countries).
